It launches the completed five-book Biography of an Earther series but can be read on its own. The remaining four installments evolve from a personal coming-of-age story to a saga that culminates in galactic war and explores themes of generational trauma, cultural survival, and redemption. I'm currently developing three other trilogies in the same universe based on key characters from David's story.
